Literacy & High School Equivalency

- Students develop their reading, writing, and math proficiency at all skill levels emphasizing preparation for the Official GED®, life, and work.



English For Speakers of Other Languages (ESOL)

- Students develop their reading, writing, speaking and listening proficiency at all skill levels emphasizing fluency and accuracy in spoken and written English.
- We offer sector-specific English courses as well as academic English, civics, and GED®/ESOL.



College & Career Readiness

- Students connect to post-secondary/workforce development and training partners.
- We assist students by bridging the skills between high school equivalency (HSE) education and college and career advancement.



Current Class Offerings, Enrollment and GED® Test Information

- Classes are offered in-person, virtually, or through self-paced distance education at no-cost to the individual.
- Students must be 18 years old (can be 16 & 17 if officially withdrawn from school. Must have official documentation prior to enrollment.)
- Project Learn is the only Official GED® testing center in Summit County.
- The cost of the GED® is \$120. First time GED® test takers are eligible for an \$80 voucher. GED® retakes are \$10 per section. There are four sections: math, science, social studies, and reasoning through the language arts. Tests can be taken one section at a time.
